

UNION LEAGUE DRESS CODE

Center City League House

It is the intention of the dress code to provide guidelines within which each Member is expected to demonstrate discretion and good judgment. It is the responsibility of each member to conform to the dress code and to ensure that family members and guests do so as well. All children in the League House are expected to be appropriately attired, and children over the age of twelve are required to conform to the dress code.

For men: Collared shirt and slacks are always required on the first-floor members-only section of the League House. Ties are strongly preferred.

Not Permitted: Turtlenecks shirts, collared shirts open more than one button, untucked shirts, jeans, t-shirts, sneakers, and flip-flops.

For women: Business suits, tailored pant or skirt ensembles and dresses.

Not Permitted: Spandex, open midriffs, halter tops, shorts, leggings, extremely short hemlines (not more than 3" above the knee), jeans, t-shirts, sneakers, and flip-flops.

Unacceptable Attire: The following attire is never acceptable on the first or second floors of the League House: jeans, denim wear, tee shirts, athletic wear, tank, halter, or jogging tops, untucked shirts, collared shirts unbuttoned more than one button or two inches from the neckline, wrinkled clothing, shorts, baseball caps, spandex, open midriffs, leggings, extremely short hemlines, sneakers, extremely casual or beach footwear.

Exceptions: Breakfast: Business casual attire is acceptable in the Founders Room or Café Meredith for breakfast only.

Saturday and Sunday: Business casual attire is acceptable on Saturday until 5:00pm and all-day Sunday in the Café throughout the year.

Private Dining/Meeting Rooms: Business casual attire is acceptable in private meeting rooms or for private dining events.

Summer Dress: Except for the 1862 dining room and bar, business casual attire may be worn throughout the League House from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

Business casual attire: Defined as collared shirt and pressed slacks for men and comparable attire for women.

The Guard House

Dress is smart casual. Collared shirts are required and must be tucked. Blazer is preferred, but not required. Dark, well fitting, dress denim is allowed. No sneakers, ripped clothing, or T-shirts.

Union League National & The Union League Golf Club at Torresdale

Collared shirts are required and must be tucked. Blazer is preferred, but not required. Dark, well fitting, dress denim is allowed. No sneakers, ripped clothing, or T-shirts. From Memorial Day to Labor Day, Bermuda shorts and sandals are allowed. No flip flops.

The Bungalow

Resort wear is allowed. For women, dresses, skirts, linen pants, khakis, slacks. For men, polo shirts, collared shirts, khaki pants, linen pants. Dark, well fitting, dress denim is allowed.
